# **Introduction and Objectives**







Sent out to Pre-veterinary club, Blue Pearl Hospitals in the Phoenix Metropolitan Area, and advertised on social media




Patterns and trends were drawn from the survey results to see the prevalence, and possible solutions for compassion fatigue in the veterinary field





Training and preparing veterinary workers for the emotional effects of veterinary medicine should start as early as in one's education (undergraduate, vet tech/vet med school). Management and companies should also take more notice to their employees needs and provide compassion fatigue specific resources, rather than generic therapeutic resources.
