STRENGTHS of redesign

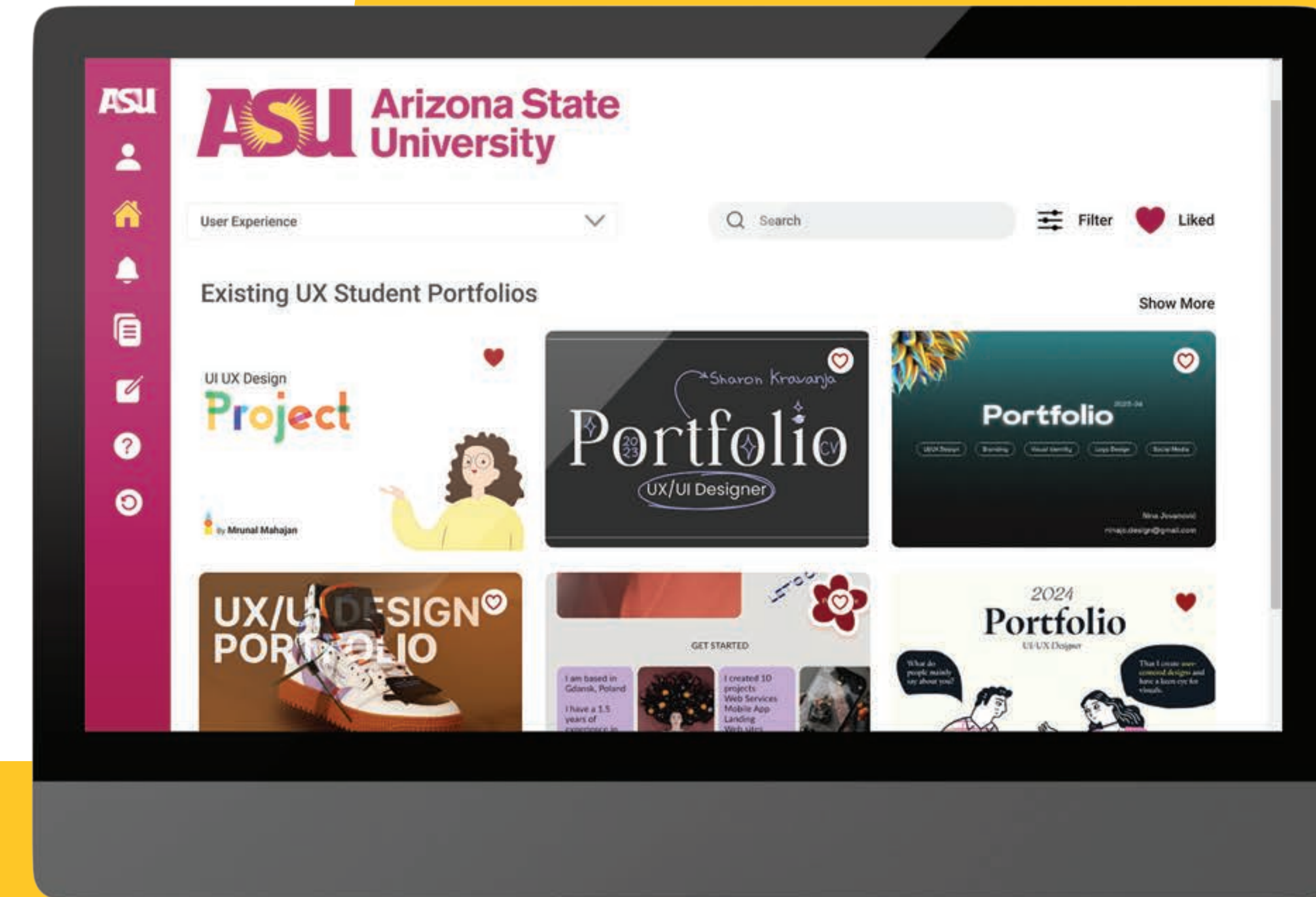
User Benefit:

- Empowerment through a dedicated dashboard for design inspiration.

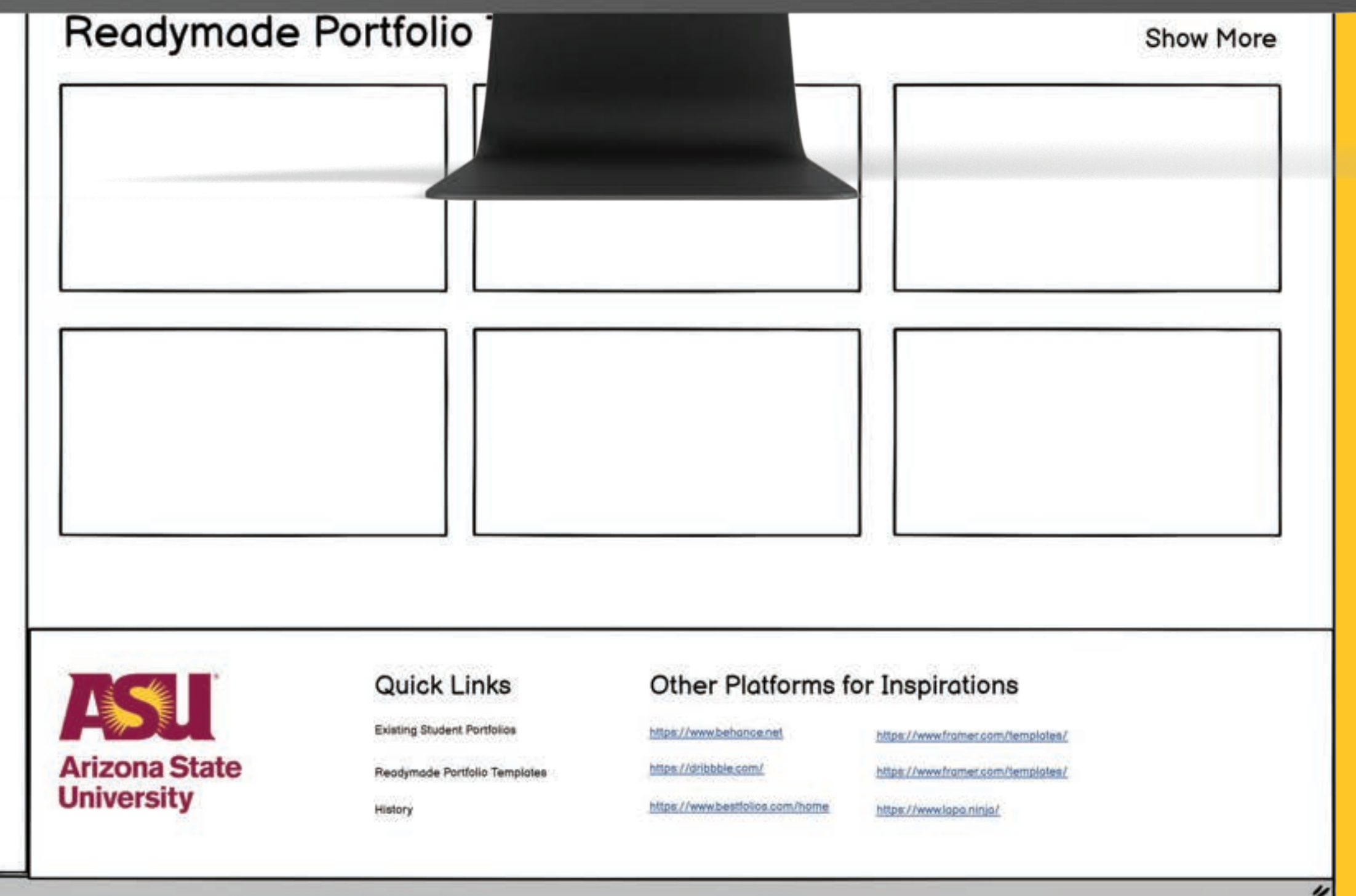
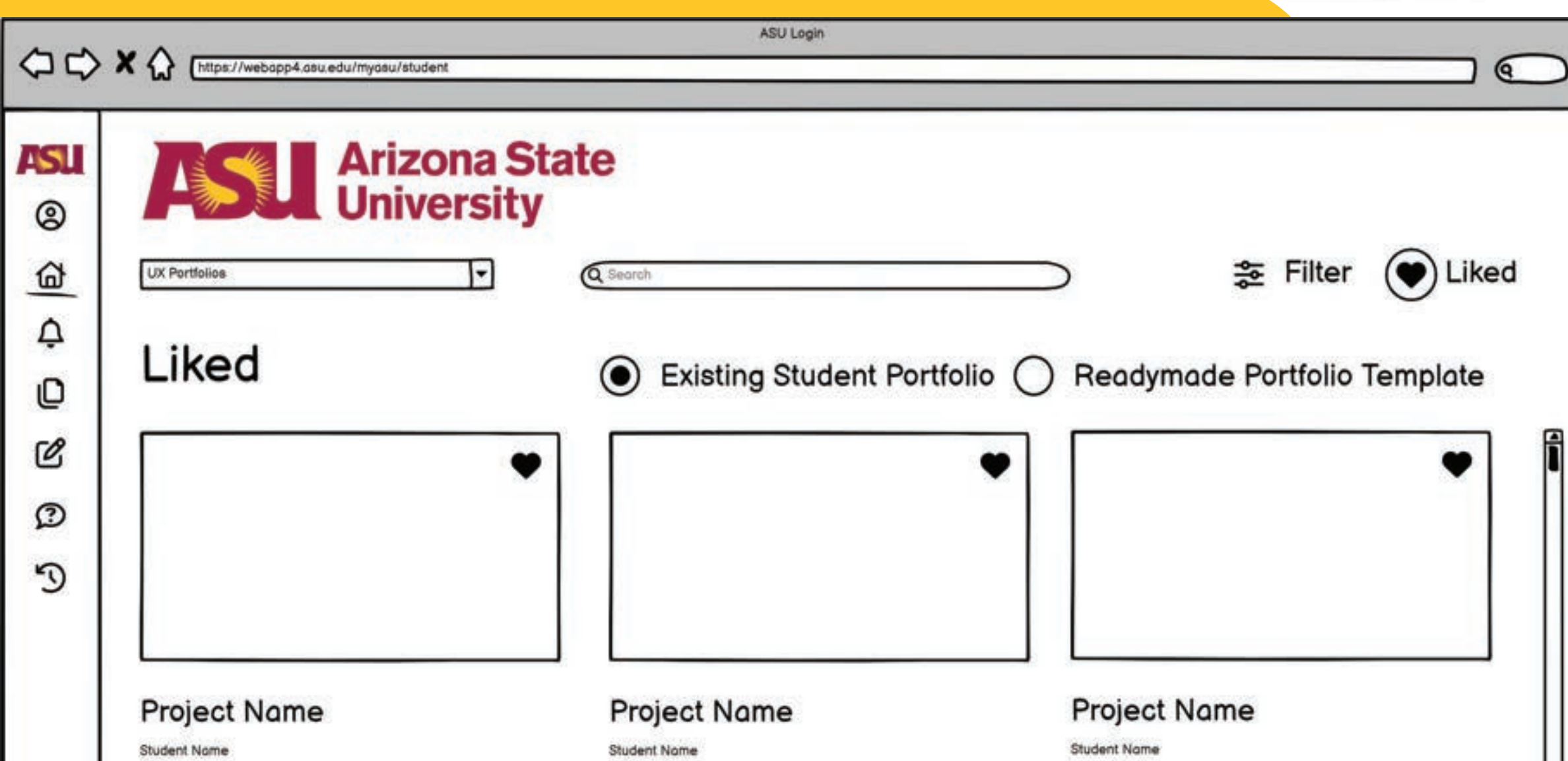
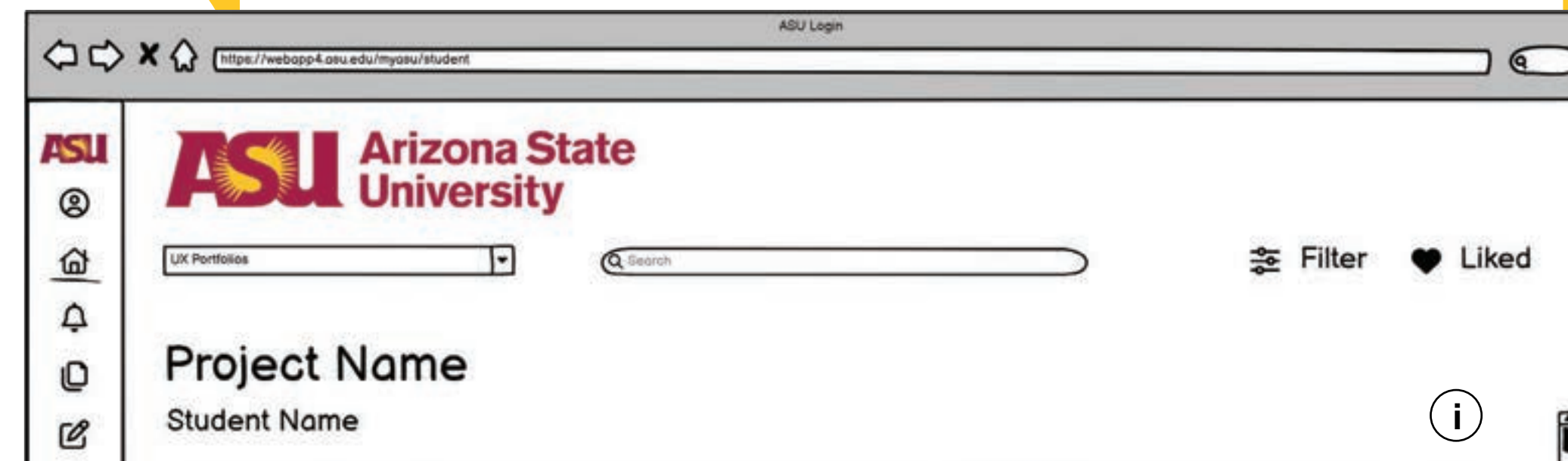
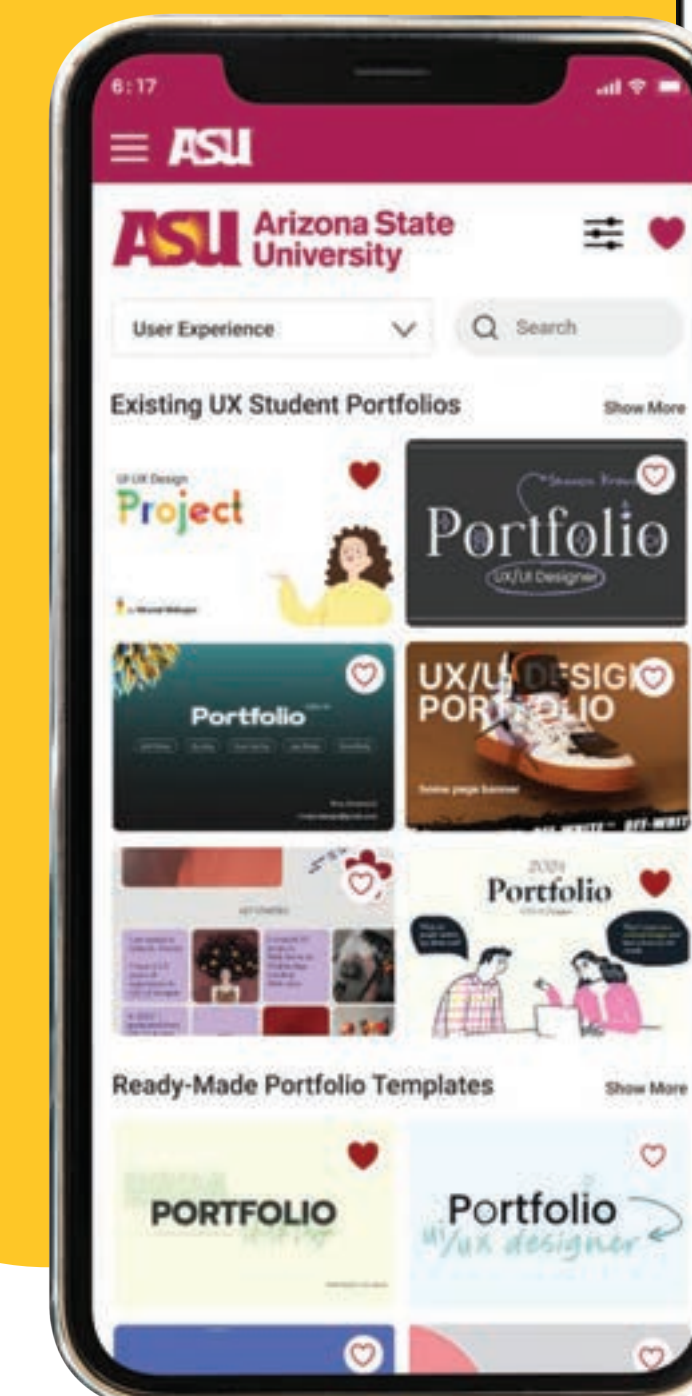
